The conference is held at Camp Ida-Haven in McCall, ID. The camp is run by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. Guests must provide their own towels, toiletries, and bedding. Separate men's and women's groups are in cabins and lodges. We will accommodate married couples where possible.

Meals will be in the camp cafeteria. Meat, fish, and poultry are not served. Dairy products and eggs are used. If you have special dietary needs, please let us know two weeks in advance and we will try to accommodate you. Your help with dishes and vacuuming of rooms before departure will be expected.
