Accommodations

We have changed the venue for the 2019 conference. The conference will be held at Pilgrim Cove in McCall, ID. Pilgrim Cove is run by the Nampa United Church of Christ (UCC) along with other UCC churches in Idaho. There are variety of cabins and RV spots available. If you choose to stay at the site, the cost of lodging will be included in your registration fee. Once you have registered and paid, you will call the Pilgrim Cove at 208-634-5555 and reserve the lodging of your choice.

A map of the grounds and cabin information have been provided (see last two pages). Please note the cabin you select may have other guests in there as well. Guests must provide their own towels, toiletries, and bedding.

The camp/event center is not ADA compliant; however, handicap assessable restrooms are available at the main lodge and one handicap assessable cabin is available as well.

Meals will be served in the dining hall. The camp will accommodate special dietary needs the best they can. Their kitchen is nut free except for almond milk. Guests may have nuts in the dining hall. If you adhere to strict dietary guidelines, please see the conference menu below and make sure to plan accordingly.


Directions to Pilgrim Cove

Heading north from Boise/Cascade.

- Turn RIGHT on Deinhard Lane (first stop light by Ridley's)
- Continue down Deinhard Lane for .5 miles
- You'll come to a stop sign at Sampson Trail, turn LEFT
- Sampson Trail turns into Spring Mt. Ranch Blvd., follow this for 2.2 miles
- At the stop sign, cross Lick Creek Rd., onto Pilgrim Cove Rd.
- Continue driving for .3 miles and turn RIGHT at the stop sign there will be a Pilgrim Cove Camp sign on the right
- Stay right to the far right
- Follow the road for .2 miles, stay LEFT and go up the hill
- The camp is approximately 250 feet ahead and you'll see a big blue welcome sign

Heading to Pilgrim Cove from downtown McCall (Fogglifter Coffee).

- Head south toward Railroad Ave.
- Turn LEFT onto Railroad Ave.
- Slight RIGHT onto Pine St.
- Merge onto Lenora St.
- Turn LEFT onto Davis Ave.
- Turn RIGHT onto Lick Creek Rd.
- Turn LEFT onto Forest Cove Rd.
- Continue Straight
- Turn RIGHT onto Shady Ln. Loop
- Turn RIGHT onto Plymouth Rd.
- You'll arrive in approximately 230 ft.
